Tukhman - Tomul pass - Mujnoh range - Soen Chadyr river - river Sarah mouth

Daily route of approx. 5-6 hours, 15 km

Day 7 - Altai

A short active day

Koir - Balturdak pass - Green valley

Daily route of approx. 2-3 hours, 18 km

Day 8 - Altai

Tekeliu river - Suluarjry - Suluarjry river - Tekeliu pass

Daily route of approx. 8-9 hours, 35 km

Day 9 - Altai

River Tekeliu - Jarlu Boch pass - Yarlou valley - base camp

Daily route of approx. 4-5 hours, 10 km

Day 10 - Altai

A day hike to the mysterious Ak - Ojouk valley. Return to the base camp

Daily route of approx. 5-7 hours, altitude change 400 m

TOUR INCLUSIONS AND OPTIONAL EXTRAS

INCLUDED

Flights: advertised package price including flights covers flights from / to London and domestic flights in Russia where applicable. The airfare is not guaranteed unless ticketed. Please note if you depart from a regional airport in the UK there might be additional surcharges for flights. The package price depends on the availability of flight tickets and is to be reconfirmed by your travel consultant

Accommodation: 3* hotel DBL in Moscow, 3* hotel DBL in Barnaul, tent for 2-3 people, wooden lodge "Vysotnik" (western style toilet outside, sauna), base camp Ak-kem (local style toilet outside, sauna)

Meals: full board while horse riding. No meals on transfers

Transport: coach, horses

Equipment and gear on a tour: equipment for camping and field kitchen, dinning dishes, tents for 2-4 people

Tour staff and support: English-speaking guide, a horseman, a driver

Local culture and traditions: all excursions, entrance fee as described in the itinerary

Russian visa: standard Russian visa processing within the UK, invitation letter to Russia

Other services: all airport transfers within Russia

NOT INCLUDED

Personal travel insurance, optional excursions and services, sauna (from EUR28 per group of 1-5 people)

SPECIAL EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

Good waterproof and three season sleeping bag, foam sleeping mat, rubber or leather high boots for riding, windproof clothes, waterproofs, warm clothes, spare socks, hat or cap, gloves, swimming items, personal hygiene items and first aid kit, matches or lighter, torch, sunglasses, mosquito repellent, sunscreen, spoon, plate, mug and knife.

INFORMATION ABOUT VISAS

Go Russia provides assistance in processing visas and visa fees are included in the cost of most of our trips as detailed in the tour dossier. The visa application process is very straightforward. Please do not worry that your application will be unsuccessful (unless you have had any immigration issues with the relevant authorities in the past). All our tourists get their visas.

All nationalities require a full passport valid for at least six months beyond the intended length of stay. Please also make sure there are enough blank pages in your passport: Russian consulate requires minimum two blank pages.

UK residents

Upon your booking we will email you detailed guidance notes how to fill in the visa forms and what additional documents depending on nationality and your immigration status will be required. Please allow about two weeks for your visa application to be processed. Please advise us if you require your passport urgently, we can arrange urgent processing for an additional charge.

Non-UK residents

If you are not resident in the UK, we will issue official paperwork and email the required documents to you. You will need

to apply for your visa at the local consulate. The process is very straightforward and we can assist you with completing the visa forms. You will have to pay the correct visa fee at the consulate in the country of your residence.

HOW TO BOOK

Step 1 - Choose Your Holiday & Departure Dates

It is important that you choose a trip that is well suited to your interests, capabilities and experience. Step 2 - Complete the Booking Form

To provide you with a more personalised and relevant experience in all your contact with Go Russia, when you book online we ask you to register on our system. Once registered you can retrieve your bookings, brochure requests, lecture participation, update newsletter subscriptions, passenger and emergency contact details, submit special dietary requests, view invoices and receipts, download trip documents.

When booking by email or over the phone please confirm your personal details (full name and address), chosen tour, departure date, package type (hotel / cabin category), and available upgrades.

Step 3 - Confirmation of your booking

On receipt of your booking form, we will make any necessary reservations for you and send you confirmation invoice, including the flight details, and additional information about your destination: advice on visas, vaccinations and what to take. The invoice will also show you the exact due date of the payment.

Step 4 - Payment

Please note, if your departure date is more than 56 days you will need to pay the deposit, which should cover the full cost of the flight (if applicable), plus 10% of the land-only arrangements (minimum £100) per person towards your tour. The outstanding payment must be made 56 days prior to departure. If you book less than 56 days before departure, full payment must be made at the time of your booking. You can make your payment by bank transfer, debit or credit card (2% surcharge applies for credit card payments), cheque, bankers draft or postal order. You will find all relevant payment details in your invoice.
